Friday, July 14 (for registered guests)

6:00 - 10:00 pm: Join us for wine and cheese, hors d'oeuvres, and microbrews as we greet our out-of-town guests and diehard locals. Meet new friends and get reacquainted with old ones. Check in at registration for your personalized lanyard. It's your ticket to all the festivities. For you long-haulers... could the end of the road look any better?

Saturday, July 15 9:00 am: Meet at Gould's for some high-octane coffee, bagels and pastries. Registration continues until 11:00 am. Prep and (maybe) polish cars, reunite with friends and make some new ones. Join our impromptu tech sessions as we solve last minute problems, fix some bugs, exchange info and parts, and share rides in each other's cars.

11:00 am: THE FIRST BIG EVENT This extended Micro-tour departs for Wachusett Mountain where we'll traverse mountain road and ascend to the top of the peak!
